**Eligibility:** All current season USBC Youth members. Non-members may pay a Tournament Participation Fee of \$2.00 in addition to the entry fee. (See rule 402.2)

**Average:** Highest sanctioned league average as of January 1, 2012 with a nine (9) game minimum; six (6) game minimum for bowlers bowling 1 or 2 games per league session. If no minimum January 1, 2012 league average, highest 2010/2011 sanctioned league Book Average. If no January 1, 2012 qualifying league average or 2010/2011 sanctioned league Book Average, current nine (9) game or six (6) game (depending on games bowled per league session) average, as of March 24, 2012 will be used. If none of these averages exist, the bowler will be required to bowl scratch.

**Male Divisions:** A. Averages of 165 and above (SCRATCH DIVISION)  
B. Averages of 130 thru 164  
C. Averages of 129 and below

**Female Divisions:** D. Averages of 130 and above  
E. Averages of 129 and below

**Mixed Division:** F. **Roll-n-Grow Division (MUST be bowling in a Roll-n-Grow League)**

**NOTE:** A minimum of seven entries for each division is considered to be the best for the tournament, but if there are less than seven for a division, the tournament director will have the option of adjusting divisions to ensure that there are seven entries per division or allowing a division to be held with less than seven entries, whichever is considered to be the best for the bowlers. If an adjustment of divisions is not agreeable to an entrant, they will be given the option of a refund of their entry fee. Girls with averages over 165 will have the option to enter the SCRATCH Division.

**Handicap:** 90% of 220.

**Tournament Play:** For the Roll-n-Grow Division, two (2) games will be bowled with bumpers on the same pair of lanes. Divisions C and E will bowl four (4) games. For all other divisions, six (6) games will be bowled. Bowlers will move one pair of lanes to the right after each game.

**Awards:**

Scholarships will be awarded for all Divisions on a ratio of one for every three entrants, with a minimum of 2 Awards in Division A and 1<sup>st</sup> Place Scratch and 1<sup>st</sup> Place Handicap in Divisions B, C, D, E & F. Scratch will take precedence over handicap. Scholarships will be guaranteed for each division as follows:

**DIVISION A:**

Scratch:	1 <sup>st</sup> Place	\$100.00
	2 <sup>nd</sup> Place	\$ 75.00

**DIVISIONS B, C, D, & E:**

Scratch:	1 <sup>st</sup> Place	\$100.00
Handicap:	1 <sup>st</sup> Place	\$100.00

**ROLL-N-GROW DIVISION:**

Scratch:	1 <sup>st</sup> Place	\$50.00
Handicap:	1 <sup>st</sup> Place	\$50.00

Additional Scholarships may be given, depending on the number of entries received for the tournament, per each Division. Scholarship funds will be forwarded to the SMART Program at the National office of USBC. Scholarship winners will be contacted by SMART concerning the use and redemption of the scholarship.

**Other Rules:**

All USBC Tournament and General Playing Rules and Regulations will apply with the following options:

Any tie scores for scholarship at the end of the tournament will result in duplicate awards being presented.

**Fees:**

For the Roll-n-Grow Division, the entry fee will be \$9.00 (\$3.00 lineage and \$6.00 scholarships). For Divisions C and E, the entry fee will be \$19.00 (\$8.00 lineage, and \$11.00 scholarships). For all other Divisions, the entry fee will be \$23.00 (\$12.00 lineage and \$11.00 scholarships). Awards will be returned 100%. **Please make checks payable to "CCUSBC".**

**Dress Code:**

Appropriate tournament dress code is required. All entrants must wear a shirt imprinted with their name, name of bowling team, league, club or center logo OR a collared shirt with sleeves. Boys shall wear pants or walking shorts. Girls shall wear pants, skirts or split skirts/walking shorts. All skirts/walking shorts must be no more than 2 inches above the knee. Apparel made of elastic or spandex type material will not be permitted. Clothes must be clean and in good repair. Parachute pants, warm-up suits or fleece garments are not allowed. Pants may not be sagged or dragging on the floor. No headgear of any kind may be worn. No bare midriffs. Bowlers will not be allowed to check-in unless properly dressed. In case of a question regarding the bowler's attire, a committee of at least three Tri-County YABA Youth shall determine if the bowler meets the dress code requirements.

**Entry Form:**

The entry fee must accompany the entry form. This form must be received by the tournament committee or placed in the USBC box at either Gold Dust West or Carson Lanes by 12:00 noon on March 24, 2012. **Entry forms will be accepted, with no LATE fee charged, if a phone call is made to the tournament director prior to the tournament date. Walk-in LATE entries will be charged a LATE fee of \$5.00. All LATE fees will be added to the scholarship fund for this tournament.** All bowlers, who are not Carson Country USBC Youth bowlers, must provide proof of their average according to the average requirements.

**Check-in:**

Check-in will be one half hour prior to the starting time of the tournament. There is only one squad for this tournament. The squad time and place of the tournament is shown on the entry form.
